

STIPULATED FINAL JUDGMENT AND ORDER

Plaintiff United States Trustee Patrick S. Layng, by Attorney Laura D. Steele, filed a complaint seeking the denial of Defendant Jason M. Neilitz's discharge under 11 U.S.C. §727(a)(3), (4)(A), (5), (6)(A), and (7) and Defendant Erica Neilitz's discharge under 11 U.S.C.

§727(a)(3), (4)(A), (5), and (6). On February 15, 2023, defendant Jason Neilitz signed a stipulation for entry of judgment and denial of discharge and the United States trustee filed a motion seeking to dismiss his complaint against defendant Erica Neilitz. No objections were filed. Accordingly, upon the record before the court, the Stipulation of Defendant Jason Neilitz, and the United States trustee's motion to dismiss,

IT IS HEREBY FOUND, DETERMINED, ORDERED, AND ADJUDGED THAT:

1. The United States trustee's motion to dismiss the complaint against Erica Neilitz is granted and the complaint is dismissed as to Erica Neilitz.
2. Jason Neilitz's discharge is DENIED pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §727(a)(3), (4)(A), (5), (6)(A), and (7), and
3. The clerk shall enter judgment against Jason Neilitz accordingly.
